



Mrs. Alisen Ann Williams

August 1, 1964 - August 26, 2017

Alisen Ann Williams, affectionately known by her middle name Ann, was born on August 1, 1964 in Falmouth, Trelawny, Jamaica and entered into eternal rest at the age of 53 years and 25 days on the twenty sixth day of August 2017 at the Long Island Jewish Hospital in New York after a brief bout with cancer.

Alisen Ann was the second daughter of Sylvia Barrett- Williams and Fitz-Headley Williams. Ann spent her early years in Falmouth and then in the early 1970 he family relocated to Hampden Estates Trelawny, Jamaica. She briefly attended the Hampden Primary School, before going on to Granville All-Age where she finished her elementary school education and moved on to William Knibb Memorial High and completed secondary school at Morant Bay High School in St. Thomas. Her education did not stop there, she went on to Montego Bay Community College where she studied Accounting and then vocational training in the Jamaica HEART Programme, afterwhich she landed a position at Hampden Sugar Estates as Payroll Clerk and later in the same position the National Sugar Industry, when the companies merged.

Upon the collapse of the National Sugar Industry in Jamaica, Ann who was by now a single mother, after the death of husband Lloyd Henry Williams (Junior), migrated to the USA in September 2010 where she worked as an Assistant to Psychologist, Dr. Tretick in N.J. In her new position her book-

keeping background served well as the doctor's biller/ coder and her innate patience was an asset when she came in contact with some of the more capricious or maladjusted patients that her employer treated.

In October of 1993 Ann married the now deceased Lloyd Henry Williams. Together they created a blended family. Ann is survived by her two daughters Demetra and Lloy-Anne and three sons Darren, Romario and Aundrae along with two granddaughters Diahilia and Tiandra and her husband of four months Tony Hewling. Sisters Corrine, Natalie, Adian and Juliet. Brothers Ian and Calvin, aunts and uncles. Also a slew of nieces, nephew, cousins and many other relatives and loved ones.
