Ida Myrtle Daniel was born on October 20, 1925 in Bartow, Georgia to the late John and Ida Hilson. Ida was the second youngest of eleven children. She attended the county school until grade seven. During the next year she worked as a teacher's assistant for kindergarten and first grade. The following year she attended Wadley High School.

Ida moved to New York City where she met and married Eddie Daniel in December 1948. They resided in Far Rockaway Queens in the Redfern Houses with their five children until Eddie's passing in September 1959. Ida then moved to 1194 Greene Ave in Brooklyn, New York in 1961 with the help of Douglas Brown, a family friend which her husband asked for him to see after his family upon his passing. After moving to Brooklyn, she gave birth to two children sired by Douglas Brown.

Ida raised her children with a hard hand and lots of love. You would hear those famous words that only she could say with authority, "Got the mighty knows, and I'm a

lie then.”

Once you heard those words you knew that Ida was not playing. Ida’s strict rules

helped her children to succeed and learn life’s lessons with open eyes.

where they resided with her remaining children, Sandra and Jeffrey until she was called

home on Saturday, August 24, 2024.
