Lois Elaine Harry was born in Brooklyn, New York, on August 31, 1946, to parents Mildred Hurley Johnson and John Johnson, both deceased. She was the first child of that union and was later raised along with her three younger brothers by her mother and father.

Lois attended St. James Pro-Cathedral School, Prospect Heights High School, CUNY, American Institute of Banking and Marymount Manhattan College. Later, Lois worked for the New York City Police Department as a Communications Technician Operator.

In 1964 she began a friendship with her future husband, Raymond Harry. Within three years that friendship blossomed into romance, and the two were married on May 27, 1967. From that union their two sons were born - Raymond Sean Harry and Austin Johnson Harry. Lois and Raymond were married for 45 years before his death in 2012.

Lois enjoyed a number of interests and hobbies. She was known for her arts and crafts which resulted in her starting her own small business for children's wear, Elaine's Knits, Inc. Lois was an avid lover of bowling as well as tennis and often played both before her illness. A natural beauty, Lois tried her hand at being a plus size model before devoting full-time to the care of her ailing parents.

On May 18, 2023, Lois succumbed to her heroic battle against several illnesses. She is survived by her three brothers John Johnson, Patrick

Johnson, André Johnson, sister-in-law Sharon Johnson and a number of nieces and nephews, relatives and dear friends. She will be missed by all.
