“ I sent you a Mother's Day shout not realizing that you passed on 4/3/19. Our last conversation was the day after New Year's Day and you sounded so upbeat because you and I felt that you were going to beat the cancer. I had no idea that would be our last conversation.



I'm upset right now because I had no idea that you passed. Over that last several months I tried calling and texting you; even up until last week. You were always good at getting back to me but I thought with you dealing with the chemo and trying to recuperate, you would hit me back when you felt up to it. When I never heard from you, something told me to Google your name which brought me to this site. This not how I wanted to find out that you are now gone. I wish that I would have been able to see you before you left this existence. I wish that I could have attended the service and pay my respects to you and your family. I'm sorry that I was not there to say goodbye. I'm hurting right now because I lost a friend.

We have both been through some things during the years we have known each other. My fondest memory of you was when you invited me up to Peekskill, NY for the weekend back in the winter of 1991. I enjoyed that moment because at that time, I was really going through some things and you lifted my spirits that weekend. You always gave more than you received Tanya and you loved unconditionally, but that was your nature.

I remember when you told me that you were pregnant with Shakur, and I watched as your belly grew over the next nine months. Considering how slim you were, you really struck out there. I use to tease you that you would knock over some dishes with your stomach if you turned sideways. You always got a good laugh from that. You seemed really happy that you were going to be a mother, and I was happy for you.

At first, I was not going to post anything to the tribute wall. But after

a few days, I figured that it was only befitting that I say something to honor your memory and to say goodbye.

You have always been there when I needed someone to talk to. I will never forget you Tanya.
