How sweet it is at evening – after a long and well-spent day – to close the eyes in slumber and rest from the toil of the day! This heavenly rest came for our Champion, Mr. Ulysee Dunbar, at 8:59 PM on November 8, 2021.

Mr. Dunbar, son of the late Newler Mae Dunbar Barnwell, was born on October 2, 1929, in Camp Branch (Varnville), SC. In his late teens, he left SC for New York where he enjoyed a well-spent life. After being gainfully employed in a laundry for a number of years, Mr. Dunbar became a truck driver and for more than 60 years, he delivered myriad supplies for various businesses, particularly, those in the food industry. In September 2019, he drove his last mile as a long-distance trucker retiring from Adolph Trucking Company.

A man of unshakeable faith, Mr. Dunbar accepted Christ as his Lord and Savior at an early age. He loved singing and sung in various churches on many programs. His love for singing God’s praises led him to singing with the Mighty Gates, in the late 1940s, and continuing with Charlie Story and the All-

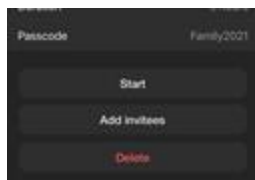

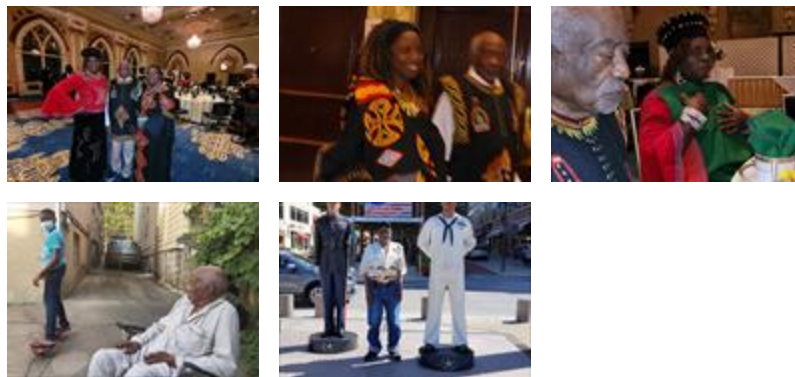
