Mother Victoria accepted Christ at an early age at the Shiloh Baptist Church and a graduate of Kimball High School in Maitland, West Virginia.

At the age of 18 she relocated to Brooklyn, New York where she met and married the late Mr. Washington and together they had two daughters: Fazella Tuning (deceased) and Sharon Hunt of Brooklyn, New York.

For forty plus years she worked for Pride Laundry and retired at age 62.
